COMMUNITY BENEFIT FUNDING 2019

Is your group, organisation or society in need of funds for its activities or projects? If so, Bradford & Cookbury Parish Council may be able to help.

The Council has reached an agreement with the owner and operator of the Dunslan Cross Wind Farm for discretionary funding of £12,000 per annum for activities and projects which can benefit our local community.

The fund was oversubscribed in 2018 so the funding committee will be operating a 'window of opportunity' system for new or re-submissions in 2019. Bids will be considered in order of receipt.

**Applications for 2019 may be submitted
between 1st February and 30th April.**
